Story-Chunking by Word Count

- 1. Know your word count.
- 2. Divide your info into parts of story (like lede, background/context, Nut Graf, Themes 1)
- 3. Assign their IMPORTANCE and PLACE in story.
- 4. You can use subheads/section titles at least to help you organize, but you might need to remove them when the story is done.
- 5. Match word count with the IMPORTANCE.
- 6. More important more words. But you can also vary the word-length to give variety to the eye and ear for the audience.
- 7. Write the individual chunks, shooting to match the word count for it.
- 8. Be sure to subtract the words for each chunk, so you can adjust as you go along.
